- 8. A very good morning to all. Thank you, Huawei Malaysia, for giving me such a warm welcome to the HUAWEI Malaysia Ecosystem Conference 2019.
- 9. Congratulations for establishing this great platform that will gather some of Malaysia's top app development talents for the opportunity to take their ideas to the next level.
- 10. As I listened to Miss Kim who shared with us the agenda of this conference, I was made to understand that this conference is one of the biggest platforms to date, bringing private sector players, industry experts and public sector support together to enhance the country's app development ecosystem.
- 11. This collaborative efforts by Huawei, a global technology company together with Malaysia Digital Economy Corporation or MDEC; and Malaysia's leading fully-integrated media company – Media Prima Berhad, will benefit not just local app developers, but also all Malaysians as a whole.
